#### THIRD NATIONAL FESTIVAL



The Third Annual RSCM France Choral Festival was held in the American Cathedral in Paris on Saturday 20 October 2018. It was directed this year by David Hill, Director of the London Bach Choir. The Festival attracted about 35 singers, many of whom had travelled some distance to be at the event. The music for the Festival was taken from the RSCM Festival Service Book, 'King of Glory, King of Peace', and included music by Guiseppe Pitoni, Maurice Duruflé, Grayston Ives and Harry Bramma. Malcolm Wisener, from St George's Church, Paris, was the organist.

### SERVICE OF REMEMBRANCE

Once again, it was both a privilege and a pleasure for the RSCM France Singers to be invited to lead the singing at the annual British and Commonwealth Remembrance Service for the Paris Branch of the Royal British Legion in Notre-Dame Cathedral on 11<sup>th</sup> November in this special Centenary year. The 70 singers were drawn from some ten choirs in the Paris area, plus visiting choristers from RSCM NW Europe, and the service featured a newly-commissioned work "My



soul there is a country", written by the English composer, Malcolm Archer. The direction of all the music was shared between Zachary Ullery, RSCM France YPO and Canon Director of Music at the American Cathedral, Paris, John Crothers, RSCM France Chairman and Martin van Bleek, RSCM NW Europe Chairman. The accompanist was Sarah Kim. Following the Service, committee members enjoyed a Reception at the British Embassy in Paris, hosted by the Ambassador, Lord Llewellyn.
