Music and folders will be provided (while stocks last), but please bring your own copies and a folder if you have them.

Under 18s

Under 18s will need to be in the care of choir leaders or other designated adults. A permission slip signed by a parent is needed for each Under 18 who is attending without a parent being present. These permission slips will be collected at Registration.

Transport

The East Berks College car park is next to Holy Trinity Church and is open to the public on Sundays at a daily rate of £4. Alternatively, use another town centre car park, or you may like to travel by train or bus. Buses to Windsor run from London Victoria, Legoland, Bracknell and Maidenhead amongst other places. There are regular trains to London Waterloo and to Slough on the London Paddington main line.

How to find the church

The church is a short walk from the middle of Windsor. From the Queen Victoria Statue which is by the Castle at the centre of the town, walk down Peascod Street, continue straight along St Leonards Road and turn right to Holy Trinity Church.

Dress code

Red cassocks and surplices will be provided (while stocks last!). Please also bring your own choir robes if you have them. Please wear black shoes.
